Re: 2022 Attendance Dues and Catholic Special Character Contribution

Dear Parents/Caregivers

I write to confirm the diocesan secondary school attendance dues and Catholic Special Character Contribution rate for 2022 and provide a brief explanation of these items:

	2022
Attendance Dues	\$655.00 (plus GST) per annum (\$163.75 plus GST, per term)
Catholic Special Character Contribution	\$60.00 per annum (\$15.00 per term)

Attendance Dues

Attendance Dues are a legal charge and not a donation. Attendance Dues are for property related costs, including compliance costs, school building works, loan repayments, building insurance and costs directly associated with the administration of attendance dues.

By way of background information, in 2021 the average diocesan Catholic secondary school attendance dues charge throughout New Zealand is \$809.22 (plus GST) and over the coming years we will be required to progressively move towards this national rate.

Catholic Special Character Contribution

The Catholic Special Character Contribution (CSCC) is a voluntary contribution. As such it is exempt from GST and is tax deductible; a 33% refund can be claimed from the IRD.

No contributions are made by the Government for attendance dues matters or CSCC services.

If you are experiencing hardship (loss of income/redundancy, family reasons, etc.) and need some financial support you are encouraged to approach your school principal to discuss your circumstances.

Please be assured that the diocese is committed to continuing to provide quality Catholic education at as reasonable a price as possible.
