



# Roncalli College: Year 10 Camp Equipment List 2019

Item	Packed
<b>Tramping Pack*</b> 70 litres in volume with harness size that fits student	
<b>Yellow Mountain Safety Council Pack liner</b> (Purchase for \$5 from College office)	
<b>Sleeping Bag*</b>	
<b>Sleeping Bag Liner*</b> Cotton single sheet folded and stitched up one side and end	
<b>Wool Beanie*</b>	
<b>Sunhat and sunglasses</b>	
<b>Wool socks</b> x 3 (day, night, spare)	
<b>Shorts</b> quick dry preferable (not thick cotton as can cause chaffing)	
<b>Parka*</b> Rain jacket that is long, Waterproof and seam sealed.	
<b>Overtrousers*</b> Waterproof	
<b>Polypro top x 2*</b>	
<b>Polypro Long John x 2*</b>	
<b>Changes of underwear</b>	
<b>T-shirts x 2</b> Preferably quick dry sport type shirts)	
<b>Long trousers</b> lightweight for around campsite	
<b>Wool or polypro gloves</b>	
<b>Footwear x 2</b> One pair for the day (Good tread and laces but will get wet and muddy). One pair at campsites (Not jandals)	
<b>Wool or fleece jerseys x 2</b> (one for during the day and one for at night. The night one can be a puffer jacket)	
<b>Swimming togs and small towel</b>	

<b>Toiletries</b> Toothbrush and paste, flannel, deodorant, sunscreen, lipbalm, insect repel, sanitary requirements	
<b>1 litre drink bottle with secure lid</b>	
<b>Personal first aid kit</b> Any medication, 4-5 adhesive bandages, disposable gloves, wound dressing, crepe bandage, antiseptic wipes, combine dressing, strapping tape if use, second skin if susceptible to blisters.	
<b>Cutlery</b> Plate, knife, fork, spoon, bowl, cup, tea towel	
<b>Torch with spare batteries</b> Store batteries in torch in reverse way	
<b>Scroggin</b> 1 small snap lock bag of scroggin for each day	
<b>Travel home clothes</b> Towel, toiletries, clothes to wear home. These items stay on bus	
<b>Day Pack/School Bag</b> Stays on bus with travel home clothes, put day 1 lunch in and any gear that may be needed day 1 like the Rain jacket	
<b>Lunch for day 1</b>	
<b>Home baking</b> This is shared with their group for morning and afternoon tea on camp. A named ice cream container is ideal. Hand to students leaders on morning of camp	

## Notes

- Item's with asterix (\*) can be hired through the College in limited numbers. Please use the Gear request hire form
- Students to bring ALL gear to school the Friday morning prior to Camp to have it checked. The pack stays at school over the weekend
- Arrive to school on the Monday morning in camp clothing (poly pro top and bottom, wool socks, shoes, shorts, t-shirt, jersey, rain jacket).
- When you step off the bus you are directly into activity 1.
- **DO NOT bring:** Cell phones, jewellery, make-up, hair dryers, money
- **DO NOT wear:** Thick cotton, jeans, hoodies. Not even for travel home clothes.
- Name all items of gear
- Have plastic supermarket bags or similar so can put wet gear into the bags in pack.
